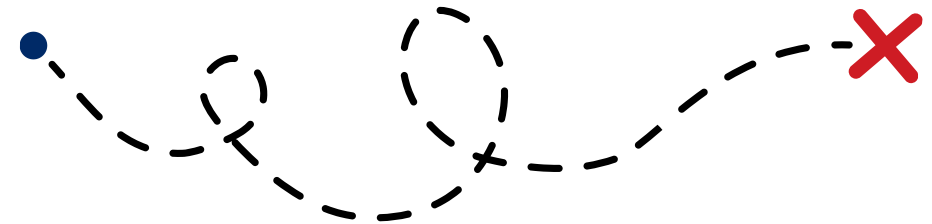


STUDENTS' ROLES



On the day of the performance, before the show, our actors spend around 30 minutes rehearsing with the 6 student actors. They go over their scenes together and give tips & tricks to help make their performance more believable. The actors also explain to the students when they need to come on stage and where to position themselves. And above all, through games and theatre exercises, the actors help the students to feel more confident and ready to give it their all on stage!



STUDENT 1

SCENE 05 - LAST SNACK

Jamie tries to leave the snack shop without paying for his food. Alex stops him.

Alex: Wait, where do you think you're going?

Alex asks a student to come up on stage as the cashier.

Student 1: Yes, you have to pay for those sausages.

Jamie: Oh sorry I got confused, It's because of that weird dude ...

Student 1: A weird dude? What do you mean?

Jamie: The big guy who bumped into me

Student 1: There is no one else in the shop.

Jamie: But the big dude, the one with the coat...

Student 1: I don't know what you're talking about.

Jamie: But ?

Alex: Err, you'll have to excuse my friend he just wants to get on the trail

Student 1: On the trail? Looking for excitement, hey?

Alex: That's right. Last stop before adventure!

Student 1: What a load of nonsense. Now get out of my shop!

The shop employee goes back to their seat.



STUDENT 2

SCENE 08 - FOREST LOST

Riley and Jamie panic and run away in opposite directions.

Alex: No, you guys, don't panic! Riley, Jamie come back! We need to stick together!

Alex exits following Jamie.

Student 2: What are you doing here kid?

STUDENT 4

Student 4: Freeze! Where are the kids?

Ranger: They were there.

Student 4: What have you done with them? What are you doing?

Ranger: Cooking.

Student 4: Cooking? Cooking the kids, you awful man.

Ranger: What?

Student 4: Why are you covered in blood?

Ranger: It's not blood. It's strawberry jam.

The student comes closer to the ranger and tastes it.

Student 4: That's not strawberry; it's blueberry! Liar! You're under arrest!

The student arrests the ranger. The Cop enters the scene.

Cop: Well done, rookie. I'll take it from here.

The student exits.



STUDENT 5

SCENE 11 - AT THE POLICE STATION

The Cop puts the ranger in his prison cell. He calls a student on stage.

Cop: Deputy, he's close to admitting it all. Give me the report, any news on your end?

Student 5: We got a phone call. One of the kids has been found in front of the convenience store.

Cop: Dead?

Student 5: Food poisoning.

Cop: Death by poison...

Student 5: No, he's alive.

Cop: Alive? Are you sure?

Student 5: Affirmative, chief, and he's already asked for another snack.

Cop: No sign of the other one?

Student 5: Negative, chief, but he said they were in an old cabin in the woods.

Cop: I knew it. Let's get talking to this kid.

Student 5: Ok boss!

The student brings Jamie on stage from behind the curtain.

Cop: So you let one get away, hey Ranger?



STUDENT 6

SCENE 13 - THREE HAPPY FRIENDS

The three friends forgive each other and share a group hug. Student 6 comes on stage.

Jamie: Oh, (name's student)!

Riley: What are you doing here?

Student 6: I came to camp in Greenpark. We got caught in the storm, a real mess.

Jamie: Just like us.

Student 6: Yeah, but it's ok; next week we're going to Red Valley.

Alex: Our Red Valley?

Student 6: The very same! Did you know that in the 50s there was an alien discovered in Red Valley?

Riley: An alien where did you hear about that?

Student 6: I heard it on the podcast Friends and Aliens.

Riley: I don't know that one.

Student 6: You should check it out. Ok, I gotta go and find my parents.

Riley: Bye, Paul!

Student 6: Ok, bye!

Riley/Jamie/Alex: Bye!

Student 6 leaves.
